2024 BY THE NUMBERS

20 aged out foster youth served in 2024:

- 4 members graduated and are employed and living in stable housing.
- 5 members are currently enrolled in 2- or 4- year college programs, with 3 of those members on track to graduate in 2025.
- Other members completed their vocational training programs as a Certified Nursing Assistant, Certified Home Health Aide, and Certified Medical Assistant; or are enrolled in programs in Radiography, Ultrasound Technician, and Patient Services Technician.

Founded in 1999, Roots & Wings is one of few organizations of its kind in the state of New Jersey that solely focuses on the betterment of the often forgotten 18-24 year old individuals who have left the foster care system without a family or home of their own to turn to for support.

Roots & Wings' provides program members with free housing and professional guidance as they focus on their educational/vocational training, the development of life skills, and their understanding of financial literacy.

While repeatedly setting and achieving goals, program members transition into adulthood with the life-changing skill set necessary to become resilient, self-sufficient, and financially independent adults.

Our mission is to provide safe housing, emotional support, life skills, and educational opportunities for youth aging out of foster care; empowering them to rise toward their greatest potential.
