

AGENCY OVERVIEW

Roots & Wings is a 501c(3) non-profit based in Denville, NJ, with scattered site housing in Morris and Union Counties. The RISE program provides free housing and support services, including access to educational/vocational training, life skills, and emotional support, to individuals aged 18-24 years old. Our goal is to empower young people who may lack the resources and skills necessary to embark on a path toward economic self-sufficiency.

By providing safe housing and the guidance of a highly trained staff, Roots & Wings enables program members to focus on setting and achieving their educational/vocational goals. Monthly house meetings and life skills groups strengthen social connections and provide opportunities to learn about financial literacy, job readiness, effective interpersonal skills, time management, and physical/mental well-being. Roots & Wings also offers tuition assistance, transportation, books, and an in-house pantry stocked with food, toiletries, and cleaning supplies. As the program members progress through the program, they gain marketable skills and strengthen the executive functioning skills (problemsolving, decision-making, coping skills) necessary to transition into adulthood successfully.

STATISTICS

- Nationally, more than 19,000 youth left foster care in 2021 without the support of a biological or adoptive family.
- More than 1 in 5 will become homeless within 18 months of emancipating.
- 1 in 4 will become parents between the ages of 19 and 21.
- Almost 50% of inmates in our prison systems have spent time in the foster care system.
- Only half of aged-out foster youth obtain their GED or High School diploma by age 19.
- Just 6% go on to earn a 2- or 4- year degree.

R&W MEMBERS ARE BEATING THE ODDS IN 2023:

- 4 members graduated from RISE into safe and stable housing.
- 100% have a High School diploma.
- 94 % were employed.
- 88% maintained a savings account.
- 81% attended an educational, vocational, or certificate program.
- 75% have their driver's licenses.
